
1. Remove your stock shift knob/shift boot and separate them. Refer to the workshop manual for your specific vehicle to do so or contact us if you require any assistance: info@sportshifters.com

Shift boots with 1 or 2 seams: use the upper side of the adjustment ring with the slots orientated in the same direction as the seam(s).



All BMW/MINI models and models and models shift boots with 3 or more seams: use the flat side of the adjustmentring facing upwards.




2. Place the adjustmentring and shift knob over the rod all the way down, but do not secure the shift knob yet. Push the adjustmentring up against the shift knob, secure the bolts andremove the shift knob again.



3. Place the shift boot over the rod on top of the adjustmentring. Shift boots with 1 or 2 seams; make sure the seams are centered in the slots of the adjustment ring.



4. Place the shift knob over the rod on top of the shift boot and push down firmly. Secure the knob with the allen key, rotating in the same direction as the arrow. This may only take 5 full rotations at most. Carefully pull the allen key out in a straight line.



Installation is now complete.
Keep the tools in your glovebox and check the bolts periodically.
Do not use chemicals on any of the parts.
